New Updated 4-H Project Report Forms

All 4-H'ers who sold a market project at the Jim Wells County Fair must follow these guidelines if they are to receive their fair check when they are first released by the Fair Association.


As stated in the Jim Wells County 4-H By-Laws, all project report forms and the original thank you notes to buyers are due in the County Extension Office by November 15 by 5:00 p.m. No emails will be accepted for project report forms. Project report forms must be completely filled out; therefore, do not leave questions unanswered. Incomplete forms or thank you notes without stamps will not be accepted. You may call the County Extension Office for a list of your buyers and their addresses.


If project report forms are not turned in by November 15th, 4-H'ers will not receive checks when they are first released by the fair association. Items turned in after the 15th must wait one week following the release of fair checks to pick-up. If items are turned in after the fair association releases checks, 4-H'ers must wait one week from the date items are turned in. Project report forms can be picked up at the County Extension Office at any time. If you have any questions while filling out the project report, please contact the County Extension Office.

Major Livestock Show Participants (Including Livestock, Contests, Judging Teams/Contests)

Major livestock show exhibitor entry deadline is Monday, November 15. This is for San Antonio, Houston, Austin, and San Angelo stock shows. 4-H'ers with animal projects must complete entries, including Quality Counts #, appropriate signatures, and entry fees. Major show entries can not be accepted without Quality Counts # and SS#. This is a requirement by all major livestock shows for both 4-H and FFA members.

Entries can be picked up early and dropped off any time prior to November 15.
